



Homeless Gear

Homeless Gear collects unwanted outdoor gear (packs, sleeping bags, etc) and re-distributes them to the homeless. We intend to find a home for all unwanted outdoor gear and make the outdoors a little more like home for those without permanent shelter.

4 Ways To Help:

1. Donate Gear. Homeless Gear has drop-off and distribution locations through-out Colorado. Specific information about these sites can be found on our website on the "locations" page. 2. Donate Cash. If you like what we are doing but simply don't have the gear to donate please consider giving us a tax deductible cash contribution. We will use your cash to go out and purchase discounted gear at closeouts, garage sales, and other value priced events. 100% of your cash donations will go to gear purchases! As one example, a \$20 donation can help us furnish a fresh pair of socks to 37 people!!
